Tenor-Bass Choir travels to UIL Concert & Sight-Reading Contest each year as a non-varsity tenor-bass choir and competes in local and regional choral competitions. Membership requires attendance at extra-curricular activities, including concerts, rehearsals, and/or sectionals.

Select Treble Choir is an auditioned choir open to ninth grade treble singers and specializes in the performance of treble choir music. Bella Voce is an advanced, auditioned choir open to tenth through twelfth grade treble singers and specializes in the performance of treble choir music. Membership requires attendance at extra-curricular activities, including concerts, rehearsals, and/or sectionals.

A Cappella Choir is an auditioned choir open to tenth through twelfth grade singers and specializes in the performance of mixed choir music. Students enrolled in the course will continue development of singing, listening, sight-reading, and music theory skills. A Cappella Choir travels to UIL Concert & Sight-Reading Contest each year as a varsity mixed choir, as varsity treble or tenor-bass choirs, and also competes in local and regional choral competitions. Membership requires attendance at extra-curricular activities, including concerts, rehearsals, and/or sectionals, and participation in the Texas All-State Choir and Solo & Ensemble processes.

Out of the Blue travels throughout the community each year and competes in local and regional choral competitions. Membership requires attendance at extra-curricular activities, including concerts, rehearsals, and/or sectionals.
